Mark and Anne opened the day with a prayerful meditation in the style of Fr Caffarel who taught that God awaits us at every moment. “The God of immense majesty and infinite tenderness awaits me, calls me, makes himself a beggar for my presence... Prayer is being present to God present.”

After a beautiful time of prayer, there were inspiring witnesses from Team members on how they have learned to make the Endeavours what they are, “concrete points of effort.” Couples generously witnessed to the immense richness of the endeavours in their lives and encouraged us to start again when we lose focus.

Paul and Annette O’Beirne, on their fourth and final visit as RC of the Super Region brought their unfailing warmth, together with an update on news from the Trans-Atlantic Super Region and the International Leading Team. In anticipation of the end of their service in January, Paul and Annette were appreciated for their solid guidance and generous leadership over those years.

Mercedes and Alberto, the Responsible Couple of the Leading Team, (ERI), were very gracious guests, mingling with the delegates throughout the day, dispensing gentle encouragement and sage advice.

Mercedes and Alberto, the Responsible Couple of the Leading Team, (ERI) spoke to us passionately about hope, in their keynote address in this Jubilee Year of Hope.

They drew attention again to Fr Caffarel's words from 1970, reflecting the hope God deposits in the human couple.

"God said, Christian couple, you are my pride and my hope." They shared "their deepest conviction that the Teams of Our Lady are a hope for the couple and the family."

They challenged us to examine how we live the endeavours, how we prepare for our meeting, how we notice the signs of hope in small and big things in the life of the couples and chaplains of our Movement.

The highlight of the day was the Eucharist celebrated by Bishop Denis Nulty, Chair of the Council for Marriage and the Family of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference. After communion, Bishop Denis performed the commissioning ceremony for Mark and Anne as the new Regional Responsible Couple and for Fr Richard Sheehy, as the incoming Chaplain for the Trans-Atlantic Super Region. Lighted candles and aprons symbolised the transition of service. The music community assisted by Alberto on the organ, accompanied the celebrations with melodious singing and music, helping us to express our joy and thanksgiving for this beautiful and unique occasion.
